1.3 Regulatory Provisions

The Director General shall have the right, (through) notices to airmen, aeronautical information circulars and notices to aircraft owners and maintenance engineers, issue special directions not inconsistent with the civil aviation law of these orders concerning certain operations and use, possession and maintenance of aircraft or operation of aircraft which fly in or over Libya-GSPAJ or of aircraft registered in Libya-GSPAJ.
