

Instructions and advice for completing this Application Form

1. Entries should be typed or printed in block letters. Full model and component designations are required (refer to the manufacturer's data plates).

Note: Applicants should clearly understand that unless all the entries on this form are completed accurately and fully, the issue of an Airworthiness Certificate may be delayed. Provisional information can be accepted for some details, on the condition that the information is provided well before the aircraft inspection date.

- 2. The charges associated with the issue of the Airworthiness Certificate will be invoiced to the registered owner of the aircraft described in Section C unless otherwise requested in writing.
- 3. The applicant may be required to provide Arabic translations of any foreign documentation.
- **4.** Applications for aircraft with acceptable evidence of conformity, should be submitted to the LYCAA not less than 28 days prior to the inspection date requested in Section F.
- **5.** Applications for aircraft without acceptable evidence of conformity should be submitted to the DGCA AS SOON AS THE AIRCRAFT ARRIVES IN Libya, or AS SOON AS THE DECISION TO REBUILD/RESTORE/RETURN THE AIRCRAFT TO SERVICE IS MADE.

NOTE : The LYCAA will decide on the basis of the information supplied whether an inspection of the aircraft will be required as part of the eligibility investigation. (This inspection is separate from the final inspection required for certificate issue.)
